

Setting

Situated on a 65 acre working croft, The Anchorage B&B affords Highland hospitality in a picturesque setting. We offer the perfect opportunity for guests who wish to relax in the peace of the countryside.

Yet we are just a short 20 minute drive from the island's capital, Portree. And we're well placed for visiting Dunvegan Castle, the coral beaches, Neist Point Lighthouse, Talisker Distillery and all of North Skye.

The house faces west and overlooks Loch Bracadale and the Ose river estuary towards the unique mountains known as MacLeod's Tables. Sunsets are often spectacular. Most of our bedrooms have this view.

The shore is immediately accessible from the house. The estuary is the home territory of herons, ducks, oyster catchers and seals. It has recently become the summer home of a flock of geese. If you are lucky, you may see the local otters in the river mouth.

Unwind in this peaceful crofting setting. Awake to the sound of seabirds, watch seals playing in the loch or sunbathing on the rocks at low tide, or spot the heron fishing at sunset.
